Read Mark 8:31-9:1

How would you define what the "things of God" are and "what the things of men" are?

What is one big way a student can pursue the "things of God" while in college? What is one big example of how the "things of men" show up at Rice?

Read Mark 9:30-37

Why do you think the disciples didn't understand Jesus teaching about his death and resurrection? Are there some Christian concepts you have a hard time "understanding?"

What are some ways you find the attitude in verse 34 in your own life, or in the Christian culture around you?

Read Mark 10:17-31

What was the "one thing" that the young man lacked?

Why is it difficult for wealthy people to enter the kingdom of God? Why was the rich man sad?

How would a person know if their money was getting in the way of them from truly following Jesus?

What are other things that can keep Rice students from truly following Jesus?

How does this passage affect how you view your savings account--should you cash it out and give it all to the poor?
